UPDATE ON THE ORGAN

The organ will be removed from the church in May and will only be reinstalled when the church is ready for it. They have also confirmed with Cassie that payment will only be required once the organ is back in the church. Approximately £2,000 is held in a restricted fund in the name of the PCC.

NEW HOLE IN THE ROOF

A number of the roof tiles have fallen off the roof and it was decided to contact the Ecclesiastical Insurance to see if a claim could be made. Should the insurance company not come through the Friends will be approached as this is a maintenance matter.
