Privacy, Cookies & Responsibilities

Your privacy on the internet is important to us.

www.strettonvillage.co.uk is a website that is intended to provide information about communities in Stretton Village (including Stretton Woods & Stocken Hall) in Rutland. Information is published on matters relating to: Stretton General Information, The Stretton Village Fete, Friends of St Nicholas Church and various other affairs.

The website is hosted on a server provided by Stretton Services. Stretton Services is not responsible for, nor does Stretton Services upload all the data (content) shown on the website.

www.strettonvillage.co.uk is a basic platform to digitally publish information. It should not be considered a definitive source of legal information. We make every reasonable effort to make sure information published is accurate however we take no responsibility for accuracy.

As part of using this website, we may gather certain types of information about www.strettonvillage.co.uk website users. We would like to explain below the types of information we may collect, what we do with it and how to request correction to, or, change to the information.

We may collect two types of personally identifying information from users:

1. Personal data (such as names and email addresses)
2. Aggregated data (such as information on traffic patterns – for example how many users log into the website)

To request changes to personal data

1. Initially request the change via the appropriate organisation, eg The Friends of St Nicholas, Stretton PCC etc

Personal Data

Personal data may be collected when users provide personal data to www.strettonvillage.co.uk e.g. this could be through registering for the electronic newsletter updates and answering any surveys.

Andrew Hayns is the data controller. This means he decides how your personal data is processed and for what purposes.

Andrew Hayns and Stretton Services comply with current data protection codes by keeping personal data up to date, by storing and destroying it securely, by not collecting or retaining excessive amounts of data, by protecting data from loss, misuse, unauthorised access and disclosure and by ensuring that appropriate technical measures are in place to protect personal data.

Aggregated Information

Aggregated information, such as: which pages users access or visit and information volunteered by users, such as survey information and/or site registrations, is collected through various methods. For example, www.strettonvillage.co.uk collects IP addresses. An IP address is a number that is

automatically assigned to your computer whenever you're surfing the Web. Web servers, the computers that "serve up" Web pages, automatically identify your computer by its IP address, and when you request a page from www.strettonvillage.co.uk our servers log your IP address.

www.strettonvillage.co.uk does not link IP addresses to anything personally identifiable, so although your session will be logged, you will remain anonymous to us. www.strettonvillage.co.uk collects IP addresses for the purposes of system administration and to provide aggregate data about the volume of use on www.strettonvillage.co.uk.
